Further changes and notes

- 1. New event on the 21st of each month (if our schedules allow for it), a poll will be created with three story ideas within it.

 Dragons, Tigers and Wolves will be able to vote on which one should be turned into a very short story (likely between 2,000 to 3,000 words, and written by Alfons solely). This story will then be posted onto Patreon and Subscribestar for all paid members to read on the 21st of the following month.
- 2. Tier price changes, the reason for this adjustment is Subscribestar. The website suggests setting the lowest tier at 5\$, or what the Wolf tier is currently. We think that's too high for a tier one price, but we've learned by cross-analyzing with other content creators that Subscribestar takes approximately 46% of Donkey tier profits, while it only takes 17.2% of Wolf tier profits, and 13.7% of Tiger tier profits. These percentages vary slightly and seem to be connected to the member's country of origin.

Now why does this result in changing up the pricing of every tier, well because there still needs to be a certain amount of distance between the Donkey and Wolf tier, and we wanted to keep the setup of the Dragon tier being twice as much as the Tiger tier, and the Tiger tier twice as much as the Wolf tier.

3. We've included two new benefits for the Dragons and one for the Tigers. We aren't an art channel like many others in this field, so we've pondered for a while on how to include you furs more in our work. The naming will be conducted as follows: A poll will be set up for an upcoming story in which Wolves, Tigers, and Dragons can vote on which OC should be named (this will likely be posted on the 7th of each month). Afterwards (likely on the 21st), we'll set up a post where Tigers and Dragons can each write down two names, perhaps only one in the future, in case the number of supporters rises. As for the discount benefit, we don't think it needs any explanation in all honesty.
